Time Signature: It tells you how the music should be counted.

Measure: A specific number of beats defined by the time signature.

Bar Line: A vertical straight line between measures.

Count: 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2.

1) You just heard 4 measures.

2) There were 2 beats in each measure.

3) So there were 8 beats altogether in the whole piece.

Explanation : 4 groups of 2 beats = 8 beats  
 $4 * 2 = 8$

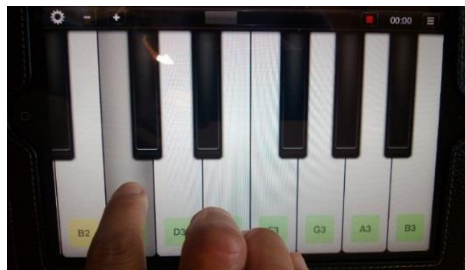
