

Vocabulary review: Time Signature: It tells you how the music should be counted.

Measure: A specific number of beats defined by the time signature.

Bar Line: A vertical straight line between measures.

<u>Example:</u>



Answer page: (Part 1.)




1) You just heard 3 measures.

2) There were 3 beats in each measure.

3) So there were 9 beats altogether in the whole piece.

Explanation : 3 groups of 3 beats = 9 beats 3 * 3 = 9




