

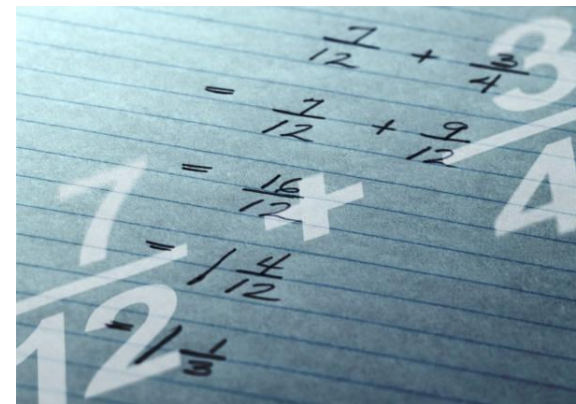


# Fraction Through Music

$$\frac{2}{2} = \frac{4}{4}$$

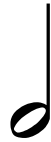




# Fraction Music Game

The correct answer is:

A.



1, 2.

$$\frac{1}{2}$$

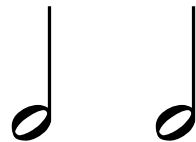
B.

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{3}{2}$$

C.



1, 2, 3, 4.

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{2}$$

Fantastic!



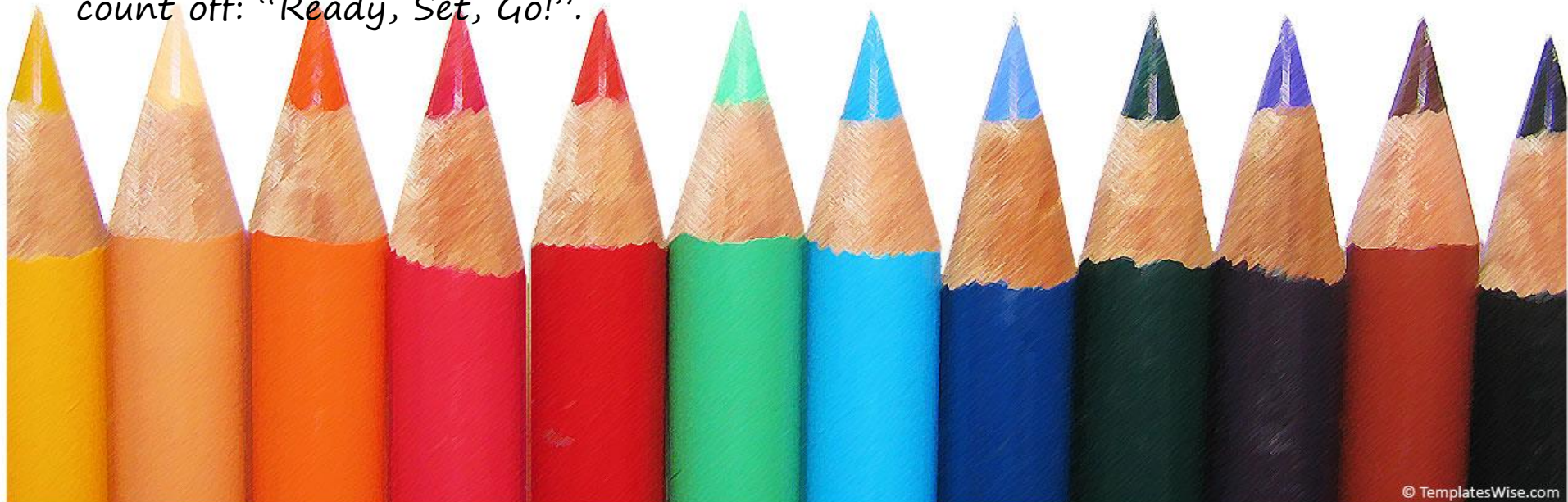


# Fraction Music Game

(For this part you can work with one friend or a group of friends)  
You get to play 3 musical pieces (examples). One is going to be the correct answer and that will be equal to 4 beats just like the whole note. Play the other two pieces shorter or longer for 2 – 6 counts. Use only half notes.

As the music is performed, ask your friend(s) to keep counting in their head along with each musical pieces. Remind your friends that the musical piece has to be equal to 4 counts (beats).

Before you start to play, please tell your friend which musical piece you will play, for example: "Example A" and start your music with a count off: "Ready, Set, Go!".
