



Fraction Music Game

(For this part you can work with one friend or a group of friends) You get to play 3 musical notes. One is going to be the correct answer and that will be an eighth note. Play the other two notes longer for 2 - 4 counts.

As the music is performed, ask your friend(s) to keep counting in their head along with each musical note. Remind your friend that the eighth note is equal to only 1/2 count (1/2 beat).

Before you start to play, please tell your friend which musical piece you will play, for example: "Example A" and start your music with a count off: "Ready, Set, Go!".


