

Vocabulary review: Time Signature: It tells you how the music should be counted.

Measure: A specific number of beats defined by the time signature.

Bar Line: A vertical straight line between measures.

<u>Example:</u>



Answer page: (Part 1.)



1) You just heard 7 measures.

2) There were 3 beats in each measure.

3) So there were 21 beats altogether in the whole piece.

Explanation : 7 groups of 3 beats = 21 beats 7 * 3 = 21

Here is how:


- 1. Print out the "Create you own music" page.
