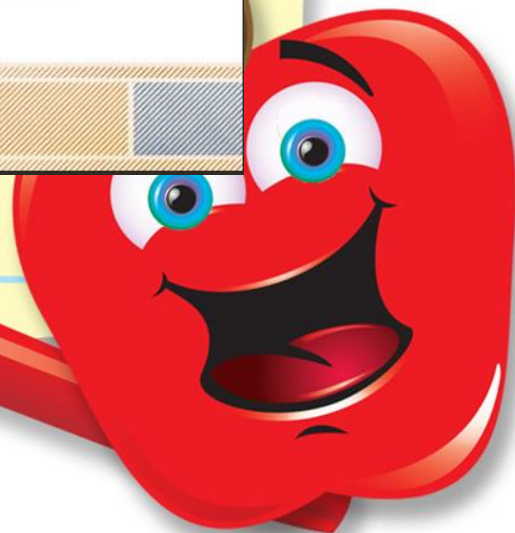

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Guided steps: How to play music in a classroom.

(Review)

Step 1.

“Start together, stay together and end together!”

Step 2.

“Ready, Set, Go!”
